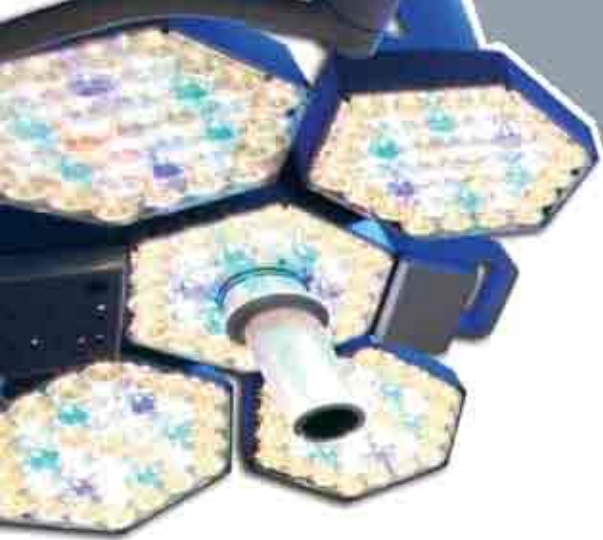

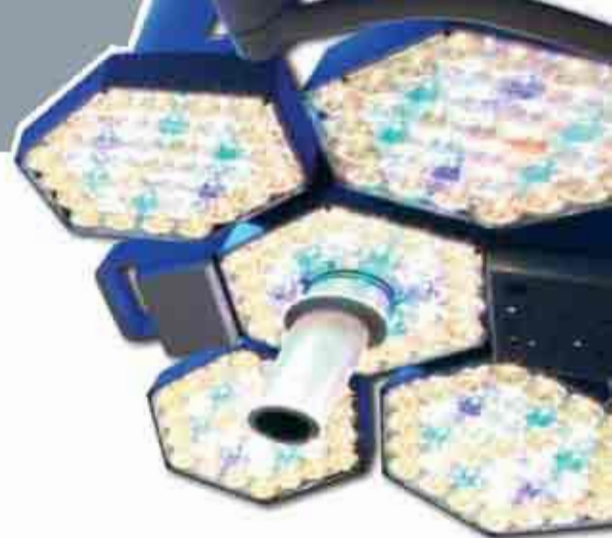

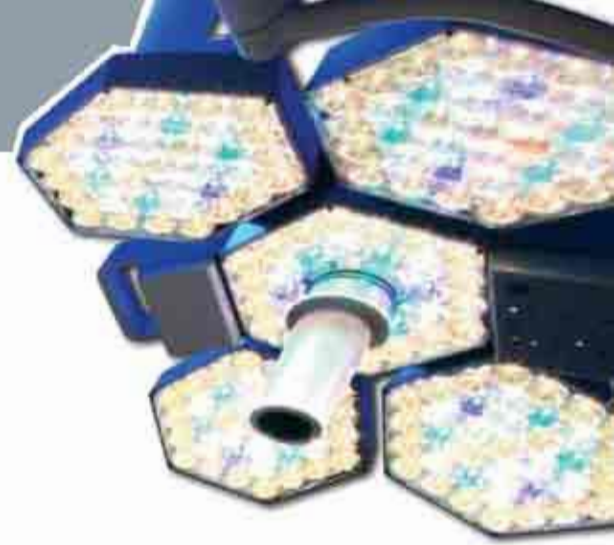

## **NAPLES**

One of the most beautiful cities in Italy, rich in history and ancient traditions and also an important trade center.

You will admire its magnificent architecture, such as the St. Andrews church, located in the middle of the town, the church tower and many other wonderful buildings.
