# Welcome in Florence



The World Congress of Pediatric and Adolescent Gynecology is the main International event of this sub specialty. First introduced in Prague during nineteen-forties by Prof. Rudolf Peters, the theme of Pediatric and Adolescent Gynecology involves both gynecologists and pediatricians, and is now acknowledged in Europe as an “area for special interest” within the field of Obstetrics and Gynecology.

Held every three years by the International Federation of Pediatric and Adolescent Gynecology - FIGIJ, the 18<sup>th</sup> edition of the congress will take place in Florence, Italy, June 25-28, 2016, organized jointly with the Italian Society of Pediatric and Adolescent Gynecology - SIGIA.

Founded in the early nineteen-eighties, SIGIA firstly developed initially in Florence, where its scientifically most important and most active group still works. Co-chaired by Dr. Ellen Rome (President of FIGIJ), Prof. Secondo Guaschino (Director of the Dept. of Obstetrics and Gynecology of the University of Florence) and Prof. Vincenzina Bruni (Professor Emeritus of Pediatric and Adolescent Gynecology and founder of this branch of knowledge in Italy), the congress will bring together the major world experts in this particular area of study.

The meeting will deal with the most world relevant topics of Infantile and juvenile gynecology, such as contraception, sexual abuse, female genital mutilations, uterine transplantation, under- and over-nutrition, as well as endocrine diseases, genital neoplasms, endometriosis, infectious diseases, genital anomalies.

The congress program also includes sessions sponsored and organized by guest scientific societies, such as ESIDOG (European Society for Infectious Diseases in Obstetrics and Gynaecology), ISGE (International Society of Gynecological Endocrinology) and ALOGIA (Asociación Latinoamericana de Obstetricia y Ginecología de la Infancia y Adolescencia), which are all involved in child and adolescent health care.

The main aim of the event is the sharing and discussion of research and clinical experiences among gynecologists, pediatricians, endocrinologists, surgeons and epidemiologists, from all over the world to enhance and spread information on diagnosis and treatment of gynecological problems in children and adolescents.

Preceded by a pre-congress course on medical treatments in Pediatric and Adolescent Gynecology, held in Italian on June 24 and 25, 2016, the 18<sup>th</sup> World Congress of Pediatric and Adolescent Gynecology promises to be a high level scientific event of great educational value that should not be missed by healthcare providers who deal with gynecologic and sexual health in children and adolescents.

An examination session of the International Fellowship in Pediatric and Adolescent Gynecology, recognized worldwide by the FIGIJ, is scheduled during Congress.

The Congress offers reduced registration fees to trainees, post-graduate students and IFEPAG Fellows to favor their participation on the congress and foster the spread of knowledge regarding pediatric and adolescent gynecology among younger physicians worldwide.
